You will learn to help with camp activities, work with younger campers and, of course, have fun! **You cannot participate in CIT I and II in the same summer.** CITs go home between sessions at Keyauwee.

CIT II (Counselor - in - Training II)

If you have already completed CIT I apply for CIT II! You will learn to work with staff and campers, hone your skills as a facilitator in program areas and be certified in American Red Cross 1st Aid and CPR. At the end of your training you will graduate to Junior Counselor and be placed in a unit as junior staff for a week.

All girls must receive a letter of recommendation from the Camp Director to attend this session.
