



GSCP2P License Requirements

Below is information on required trainings. Classes marked with ♦ are available in gsLearn. Every registered adult can access gsLearn by logging into the MY GS membership portal on www.girlscoutsp2p.org.

Leader License —Required for all troops. Must be held by at least two non-related adults. Never expires.

- Current Background Check (*repeat every 3 years*)
- Successful Leader Learning Series ♦
- New Leader Orientation

First Aider —Required for specific activities as outlined in *Safety Activity Checkpoints*. Suggested that a First Aider attends all events outside of regular troop meetings. Valid for 2 years.

- First Aid Certification
- CPR Certification (*course must include an in-person skills demonstration*)

Activity & Overnight License —Required for all events outside of regular troop meetings. Must be held by at least one adult. Recommended for all Troop Leadership. Valid for 5 years.

- Successful Leader Learning Series ♦ or Girl Scouts in the Outdoors ♦
- Be Safe, Be Ready ♦

Cook Out License —Required to build fires and cook outdoors. Must be held by at least one adult. Valid for 5 years.

- Activity & Overnight License ♦
- Fire Building (approximately 3 hours)
- Outdoor Cooking (approximately 3 1/2 hours)

Camp License —Required for camping in tents. Must be held by at least one adult. Valid for 5 years.

- Cook Out License
- Tenting (approximately 3 hours)

Travel License —Required for extended travel of three or more nights. Training must be completed by adults and girls. Not appropriate for Daises and Brownies; only Juniors and above can participate. Never expires.

- Activity & Overnight License ♦ (adults)
- Extended Troop Trip Training (girls and adults)

Backpacking License —Required for overnight backpacking trips. Must be held by at least one adult. Valid for 5 years.

- Camp License
- Backpacking (overnight)
