



Girl Scouts Carolinas Peaks to Piedmont is committed to eliminating barriers to participation in the Girl Scout Leadership Experience. A Financial Assistance Fund has been established to assist those with financial hardships. Financial assistance funds are primarily used for annual GSUSA membership dues for girls. Adults required for troop leadership may also receive assistance.

The Financial Assistance Fund is not an unlimited resource, is dependent on the generosity of contributors, and trusted that those applying will carefully consider their assistance request. The amount of assistance granted is based on financial need and current budget. Due to the volume of requests, not all requests may be fully funded.
