Girl Scout Programs

Listed are suggested programs that we can offer your scouts. We also offer customizable programming depending on your goals. Each program is 2 hours long that includes 90 minutes of

programming and 30 minutes for playtime on the Playground, Water Slide or Kangaroo Jump Pillow (weather depending). Feel free to bring snacks or use the bonfire area to grill. Climate controlled restrooms are also available for your group.

1 Horsemanship Program

This program is designed for the troop that wants to learn how to care for horses, how to communicate with them and how to ride. Scouts will learn how to groom and learn the safety zones of a horse. They will also experience hand led rides around the arena as they practice walking, turning and stopping.

Horses Helping Humans Program

This program explores a horse's natural instincts and how they partner with us to assist with counseling, physical therapy and recreational use. Most of the learning is on the ground with horses.

Outdoor Farm Explorers

This program explores the barn, pastures and nature sensory trail as troops discover the ecology of various insects, animals, trees, etc.

Groups will walk up to .5 miles around the farm.

The Small Farm Animals include a pig, goats, cats, dogs, chickens and rabbits. Subject matter is determined by the season

Outdoor Art Program

This program explores nature's display of art through texture, symmetry and lines. A trail walk is included to discover these items. 1-2 projects are completed depending on the age and goals of the group. Walking sticks and horseshoe dream catchers are favorites!
