

- All Girl Scout Silver Award projects need to be pre-approved through the Silver Award Committee before getting started by submitting the <u>Girl Scout Silver Award Intent Form</u> one form per project. Troops will need to plan to submit the form at least 30 days in advance of the start of the project to obtain GSCP2P approval. Response is usually received within 14 business days. Once received, an e-mail will be sent to the Girl Scout Silver Award Committee to review, and the troop leader will be contacted with the next steps.

The Trifecta Award honors girls who have earned all three of Girl Scouting's highest awards the Bronze Award, Silver Award and Gold Award!
