

Dear Girl Scout,

To help you reach your troop and personal goals for the 2026 Girl Scout Cookie Program, we are offering a special "Buy 5" incentive for our cookie customers, troops and girls. Any customer that purchases five packages of cookies will have their name entered in a drawing to win a year's supply of their favorite Girl Scout Cookies (a total of 52 packages). The drawings are for anyone (including Girl Scouts and their family members) who purchase at least five packages, but the five-package purchase must be made during a single transaction. Multiple entries are accepted. A customer receives one entry for every five packages purchased (i.e. five packages = one entry, 10 packages = two entries, etc.).



For troops holding booth sales, please make a special container to collect entries for the drawing and label it accordingly. Your container could say something like "BUY 5 PACKAGES – ENTER TO WIN A YEAR'S SUPPLY OF COOKIES!"

One way to promote this during the Girl Scout Cookie Program and support Cookies for a Cause is to tell your customer, "Buy five packages today four packages to take home plus one for our first responders - and be entered in a drawing for a year's supply of Girl Scout Cookies, too."

Winners will be responsible for picking up their cookies from their nearest service center and will be contacted by the council to arrange for pick up. Cookies will not be shipped. All 52 packages will be awarded at once and the customer can choose the cookie varieties.

The drawings will be held on March 12, 2026.
