Cookie Program Responsibility

Parents/guardians are financially responsible for all the cookies signed out from their Girl Scout's troop. Some troops allow cookies to be returned or exchanged, while others do not. Check with your troop volunteer to find your troop's return and exchange policy before accepting cookies. If your troop does allow cookies to be returned or exchanged, you must adhere to the troop's return and exchange deadlines, or you will be responsible for full payment.

Always Get a Receipt

Cookies and money change hands frequently throughout the cookie program. Any time cookies or money changes hands, a receipt should always be issued. If you do not receive one from your Troop Cookie Manager, ask for one.
